

The Marshall Building

In April 2016, LSE announced that Dublin based practice Grafton Architects had been selected as the winners of the international architectural competition to design The Marshall Building at 44 Lincoln's Inn Fields.


The building is a concrete frame structure with two basement levels set on a raft foundation. The frame includes post tensioned slabs and exposed concrete 'tree' columns and a helical in-situ concrete feature staircase. The façade design includes pre-cast concrete panels and vertical fins to achieve the signature design associated with the Pritzker award winning Grafton Architects.

The project has required careful planning and design coordination through both the demolition and construction due to its tight footprint within a busy city centre location and the ongoing major redevelopment of the adjacent Royal College of Surgeons building.
